CITIZENS HALL OF FAME NOMINATION FORM

Award Categories

The criteria for induction to the Citizens Hall of Fame requires that the individual person must have brought recognition to Winnipeg or have made outstanding contributions to the quality of life and development of the city. The inductee's achievements may be local, national, or international in scope.

Individual persons inducted to the Citizens Hall of Fame may be honoured for their achievements in any of the following fields of endeavour:

1. **ARTS:** for endeavours which enhance and support artistic/cultural life and well-being;
2. **BUSINESS:** for entrepreneurial activity, including the establishment and successful operation of a business;
3. **PROFESSIONAL:** for pursuit of a specific profession and advancement of that profession, and;
4. **PUBLIC AFFAIRS:** for public service in areas such as social advocacy, environmental protection, international affairs, political action or organized labour.
5. **VOLUNTARY/COMMUNITY SERVICE:** for voluntary activities and dedication that benefit the immediate and global community;

Nominations or selection to the Citizens Hall of Fame is not restricted to these fields and individual persons may be inducted for their accomplishments in more than one area.

NOMINATION PROCESS

A campaign will commence to solicit nominations to the Citizens Hall of Fame. The campaign is conducted through communication to local media and organizations where nominations are requested from an individual person of the public. In addition, members of the Citizens Hall of Fame Selection Committee are invited to submit nominations.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Citizens Hall of Fame Selection Committee is comprised of a group that includes representatives from a cross section of professional organizations, educational institutions, service groups and at least three REALTOR® Members from the Winnipeg Regional Real Estate Board.

SELECTION PROCESS

All nominations for the Citizens Hall of Fame are distributed to the Selection Committee.

Nominators or their delegation will make an in-person presentation to the Selection Committee highlighting why their nominee is deserving of the Citizens Hall of Fame Award. After the presentations, the Selection Committee will review the nominations.

Each Selection Committee member receives a ballot listing the nominees and is asked to indicate their top three selections. Ballots are to be returned by a specific date. Point totals for each nominee are compiled based on 10 points for a first-place choice, 5 points for second-place choice, and 1 point for a third-place choice. The nominee with the most points will be deemed the inductee for that year. In the case of a tie, the nominee receiving the most first place votes will be the inductee.

On the day of the induction a special ceremony is held to announce the name of the honoured individual person. A bust of them is commissioned and erected at the Citizens Hall of Fame site located in Assiniboine Park.

Nomination Deadline: October 30, 2025

Nominees must:

1. Have been or presently are residents of Winnipeg
2. Be at least 18 years of age

Nominees may be nominated in one or more of the following fields of endeavour, but are not restricted to these fields:

- A. **Arts:** for endeavours which enhance and support artistic / cultural life and well-being;
- B. **Business:** for entrepreneurial activity, including the establishment and successful operation of a business;
- C. **Professional:** for pursuit of a specific profession and advancement of that profession, and;
- D. **Public Affairs:** for public service in areas such as social advocacy, environmental protection, international affairs, political action or organized labour;
- E. **Voluntary/Community Service:** for voluntary activities and dedication that benefit the immediate and global community.
